NICHOLAS L. PFEIFFER is a skilled accountant and controller with experience at multiple Fortune 500 companies and major corporations.

Currently, he serves as vice president, controller and chief accounting officer of FMC Corporation, which is a publicly traded diversified chemical company serving agricultural, consumer and industrial markets globally with innovative solutions, applications and marketing-leading products.
